Noor Ministries staff and students – your gift keeps schools like these running in Pakistan.

If you are a UK taxpayer, Gift Aid lets Noor Ministries UK claim an extra 25p for every £1 you give – at no additional cost to you. It is one of the simplest ways to make your donation go further.

• What is Gift Aid?

Gift Aid is a UK Government scheme that allows registered charities to reclaim the basic rate Income Tax already paid on a donation by a UK taxpayer. HM Revenue & Customs (HMRC) refunds this tax directly to the charity.

For every £1 you donate, Noor Ministries UK can claim back 25p – turning a £100 gift into £125, at no extra cost to you.

• How it works

You simply complete and sign a Gift Aid declaration confirming you are a UK taxpayer. One declaration can cover:

- the donation you are making now
- any donations you make in future
- donations made in the past 4 years

Noor Ministries UK then reclaims the tax directly from HMRC – there is nothing further for you to do.

• Why it matters

- Increases every donation by 25% at no cost to you
- One declaration covers past, present and future gifts
- Simple for the charity to administer – no extra effort needed from you each time you give
- Higher/additional rate taxpayers can claim further personal relief via Self Assessment or by asking HMRC to adjust their tax code

• Who qualifies?

You qualify if you pay UK Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for the current tax year at least equal to the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all your donations to all charities in that tax year. If you pay less tax than this, it is your responsibility to pay any difference to HMRC.

Please let us know if you stop paying sufficient tax, want to cancel your declaration, or change your name or address.
