

# Prayer Items for 9th June 2026

## **Global & Persecuted Church Requests**

- **Democratic Republic of the Congo:** Pray for comfort and hope for Christian families and churches who have recently lost loved ones to violent Islamist and rebel attacks in the north-east. Also pray for the region as it battles an Ebola virus outbreak.
- **India:** Pray for healing and peace for a congregation of believers who were severely injured during an attack on a Sunday morning worship service in Chhattisgarh, and for families whose homes were burned down in Uttar Pradesh.
- **Ethiopia:** Pray for God's healing and lasting peace in the Oromia region following extremist attacks on a local market and a church.
- **Myanmar:** Lift up the Christian communities suffering hostility and violence from the advancing military, specifically praying for families affected after soldiers killed two believers and burned down homes in Chin State.
- **Bangladesh:** Pray for the 97 believers who were recently baptised, as great persecution broke out immediately following their public profession of faith.

## **Local Church & Community Ministry (Hall Green & Bradford)**

- **Urdu-Hindi Church Convert (Bradford):** Pray for a local brother from the afternoon church who is being baptised. He has received death threats and severe opposition from his family due to his new faith; pray that he will act with great wisdom, discretion, and courage.
- **Grace Baptist Mission (GBM) Workers:** Pray for peace and unity among the Reformed Baptist Association churches in the Philippines, which have recently faced internal doctrinal tensions.
- **Caring For Life (CFL):** Pray for the vulnerable individuals CFL serves who face severe mental health issues, housing problems, and addictions. Pray specifically for their safety over weekends when they lack access to the farm, and that the regular April Bible studies would impact their hearts with the gospel.

## **Evangelism & Outreach Missions**

- **United Beach Missions (UBM):** Pray for the ongoing and upcoming summer outreach efforts on the beaches and in the cities. Specifically pray that the 14 children who requested Bibles during the recent holiday camps will read them, and that the seeds sown during the London "Christian Answer" mission will bear fruit among the travellers and locals who engaged with the team.
